

**COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FLOYD COLLEGE AND COOSA VALLEY TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

Floyd College and Coosa Valley Technical College join together for the purpose of providing a Cooperative Degree Program in the following areas:

- (1) AAS in Business
- (2) AAS in Health
- (3) AAS in Services
- (4) AAS in Technology

With these areas, the following program areas constitute part of this agreement:

AAS in Business includes: Accounting, Business Office Technology, Computer Information Systems including: Computer Programming, Internet Specialist – Web Site Design, Microcomputer Specialist and Networking Specialist, Management and Supervisory Development, and Marketing Management.

AAS in Services includes: Early Childhood Care and Education.

AAS in Health includes: Medical Assisting, Radiology Technology and Respiratory Technology.

AAS in Technology includes: Electronics Technology, Drafting, and Industrial Systems Technology, Mechanical Control Systems Technology, Electrical Control Systems Technology, and Industrial Electrical Technology.

The AAS degree consists of 18 or more semester hours of general education and related academic course work from Floyd College. The technical component of the degree (60 or more quarter hours) is to be completed at Coosa Valley Technical College. Credit for completion of the technical core is transferred to Floyd College as "block credit" toward requirements for the A.A.S. degree. It is acknowledged by this Cooperative Agreement that Floyd College, as the degree granting institution, is ultimately responsible for the credits which make up the degree.

In keeping with this acknowledgement, Floyd College and Coosa Valley Technical College hereby agree to:

- (a) Acknowledge that the Vice President for Academic Affairs of Floyd College, by virtue of the degree granting responsibility of that institution, is to be administratively responsible for the oversight and coordination of this cooperative program.
