



The role of the CDOC is to (1) raise, discuss, and research issues relating to the program; (2) ensure the quality and effectiveness of the curriculum; (3) facilitate the coordination of student services; (4) secure adequate resources, and (5) make recommendations to appropriate officials. The committee will also conduct needs assessment and make recommendations regarding new program areas. (A copy of by-laws of this committee is attached.);


- (c) Provide program review groups made up of representatives from both institutions who will examine, on a course-by-course basis, the components of each degree program, validate faculty credentials, and maintain an on-going program review cycle. As appropriate these groups may involve area field practitioners and representatives from other COC accredited institutions in the program review process;
- (d) Acknowledge that North Metro Technical Institute will provide housing for the program including administrative and faculty offices as well as classroom and laboratory space, as available;
- (e) Cooperate in providing library and learning resources support as defined by the attached Learning Resources Agreement For Library Services.






