## Courses

GHC offers more than 30 programs of study and 100 general core courses required for most four-year degrees. And because we are part of the University System of Georgia, those courses are easily transferrable to other USG institutions. Our flexible schedules allow for morning, afternoon or evening formats.

## Programs

Nursing is one of our flagship programs, admitting a selective group of 40 students each fall in Marietta. As a highly competitive curriculum, nursing requires SAT or ACT scores for admittance.

Our Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees are designed to provide a seamless transition among many University System of Georgia colleges and universities. Our students may also transfer to institutions around the nation.

The dual enrollment/ACCEL program for high-school juniors and seniors provides the chance to earn college credit prior to graduation.

An evening cohort format supports the needs of working professionals, allowing for a flexible sequence of courses after traditional business hours.

## Admission Requirements

- Completed college application (with fee)
- Official high school / college transcript
- Freshmen: 2.0 college prep GPA or 2.2 tech prep GPA or GED
- No SAT or ACT required for admission (However, we encourage students to take one of these tests as certain scores will exempt college entrance exams)
- Certificate of immunization
